

THE WEDDING PHOTOGRAPHY CONTRACT

1. Booking and Payment

1.1 To secure your booking, a non-refundable deposit of 50% of the total package price (including any add-ons as explained in section 3) is required, plus 100% of the travel fees.

For example:

If your package costs £1200 and you add a £200 add-on, the total is £1400.

The 50% deposit is £700, which goes toward the total.

Travel fees are paid via the same invoice and in full upfront.

1.2 The remaining balance must be paid no later than 14 days after the wedding photos have been delivered.

1.3 Payments must be made via the secure online payment method provided by the photographer.

1.4 The deposit is non-refundable under any circumstances, including cancellation by the client.

2. Additional Costs

2.1. Any additional hours of photography coverage will be charged at £75 per 30 minutes.

2.2. Travel beyond a 20-mile radius from SE18 is charged at £0.65 per mile both ways.

2.3. If an overnight stay is required for the photography due to the wedding location or coverage needs, an additional charge of £150 will apply for the photographer's accommodation and time away. This charge will be added to the deposit to ensure accommodation is secured in advance.

2.4. Any other additional requests outside the agreed package may incur extra charges and shall be discussed via email/messages before the deposit is made.

2.5. Any add-on hours decided upon on the day of the shoot will be added to the final invoice. Likewise, any add-on hours agreed between booking and the shoot date will also be added to the final invoice.

3. Cancellations and Rescheduling

3.1. Cancellations: If the client cancels the wedding at any time, the deposit will be forfeited. Additionally, any travel & accommodation fees included in the initial deposit are non-refundable.

3.2. Rescheduling: If the client wishes to reschedule the wedding, the deposit may or may not be transferable. The deposit can only be transferred to a new date, subject to the photographer's availability. If the photographer is unavailable for the new date, the deposit will not be refunded.

3.3. New Accommodation and Travel Costs: Any accommodation or travel costs already booked for the original wedding date will remain non-refundable, even in the case of rescheduling. The client will be responsible for covering these costs, as well as any new accommodation or travel charges if the wedding is rescheduled to a different date.

3.3. In the highly unlikely event the photographer cannot attend the wedding due to illness, death, fire, or other unforeseen circumstances, the following options are available:

- Substitute Photographer: A professional substitute may be arranged to cover the event.
- Adjustment or Termination: If the client does not accept the substitute, or if the photographer is unable to provide a substitute, they may terminate the agreement, and all payments (including the deposit) will be refunded.

3.4. Second Photographer: In the unlikely event that a booked second photographer becomes unavailable, every reasonable effort will be made to provide a suitable replacement. If a replacement cannot be found, liability shall be limited to a refund of the second photographer fee only.

4. Client Obligations

4.1. The client is responsible for ensuring the photographer has access to all necessary locations and venues on the wedding day.

4.2. The client agrees to inform the photographer of any special requests, limitations, or restrictions at the venues before the wedding day.

4.3. The client agrees to provide the photographer with a timeline of the wedding day at least two weeks before the event.

4.4. The photographer is not responsible for missed shots due to factors outside their control, including but not limited to inclement weather, poor lighting, or venue restrictions.

4.5. The photographer is also not responsible for missed shots resulting from failure to meet obligations outlined in 4.1, 4.2, or 4.3.

4.6. The client is responsible for keeping the event running on time. If delays occur (e.g. the couple runs late), the photographer's end time remains unchanged. Any extra time needed will be charged at the agreed hourly rate. Delays or poor communication may also affect what moments can be captured.

5. Photographer Rights

5.1. For bookings over 6 hours, the photographer is entitled to a minimum of a 30-minute break.

5.2. Additional short breaks (e.g. for restroom use) will be taken when coverage isn't essential.

5.3. Breaks are included within the booked coverage and do not extend the total time.

5.4. The photographer may briefly pause shooting to manage equipment, such as:

- Swapping SD cards
- Charging batteries
- Securing or moving gear as needed

5.5. These brief pauses are part of the normal workflow and are not considered a lapse in coverage.

5.6. The client must allow the photographer access to a safe space on-site or within the venue to securely store equipment.

5.7. The client must permit the photographer to use power outlets as needed to charge batteries and maintain equipment.

5.8. If coverage exceeds six hours, the photographer should be provided a time to eat their own meal, ideally at the same time as the couple to avoid missing key moments.

5.9. The photographer's right to a harassment-free and respectful working environment is detailed in section 11.3 of this agreement.

5.10. During periods of extreme heat or adverse weather conditions, the photographer may take additional short breaks as reasonably required to maintain personal wellbeing and prevent camera and equipment overheating. These brief pauses form part of the normal workflow and are not considered a lapse in coverage.

6. Editing & Image Selection

6.1. After the shoot, The Photographer will select and edit photos to deliver. The exact number of images is stated in the package details on the website or booking confirmation.

6.2. The Photographer controls all culling, editing, and stylistic choices, including colour and lighting adjustments.

6.3. By signing this contract, the client confirms they understand and accept the photographer's editing style. Clients may request one round only of minor adjustments on up to 20 selected images from the final gallery. Any major changes or additional revision rounds will incur extra charges.

6.4. The Photographer will aim to capture images in a naturally flattering, documentary style and may offer light direction during portraits or editorial moments. However, candid expressions, timing, and reactions remain outside of the Photographer's control. This includes the couple, wedding party, and guests in the background of key moments, where natural expressions may occur. These are part of the authentic coverage of the day and are not considered faults or grounds for re-editing.

6.5. Clients should review the Photographer's social media and website to understand the expected style.

6.6. Clients agree not to apply filters (manual or automatic) to images posted on social media to preserve the Photographer's creative vision.

6.7. Under no circumstances will The Photographer allow the delivery of RAW photo files to clients. All delivery of digital images will be in JPEG format.

7. Usage Rights and Copyright

7.1. The photographer retains the copyright of all images. The client is granted a license to use the images for personal use only.

7.2. The client may share images on social media or print copies for personal use but may not sell, license, or modify the images without the photographer's permission.

7.3. The photographer may use the images for promotional purposes, including but not limited to social media, portfolios, and marketing materials.

8. Limitations of Liability

8.1 The photographer's maximum financial liability is limited to a refund of the amount paid for the photography package.

8.2 The photographer is not responsible for partial or complete failure to deliver services or images caused by events beyond their control (e.g., natural disasters, equipment failure, transport delays, legal restrictions). In cases of full cancellation or inability to attend, the refund and substitution options outlined in section 3 apply.

8.3 If critical moments are missed due to equipment malfunction and cannot be reshot, a partial refund or compensation (e.g., extended coverage) may be offered.

8.4 If the photographer becomes ill or injured on the job, work may be halted. For non-repeatable events, a substitute will be sought. If unavailable, a partial or full refund will be provided based on coverage completed.

8.5 The photographer is not liable for loss or damage to client personal property or wedding details during the shoot. Clients should secure their belongings.

8.6 Liability for loss, corruption, or damage to digital files is limited to a refund of fees for the affected service only. Reasonable precautions will be taken to back up and protect files.

8.7 The photographer is not liable for damages caused by third parties such as venue staff, guests, or other vendors.

8.8 The photographer is not responsible for long-term storage or archiving of digital files after delivery; clients must back up and protect their images.

8.9 The final number of delivered images may vary depending on conditions (lighting, weather, timing, cooperation). The photographer is not liable for a reduced image count.

9. Unforeseen Circumstances and Event Disruptions

9.1 Transportation issues (such as accidents or breakdowns) delaying the photographer's arrival will be communicated promptly. If critical moments are missed and cannot be rescheduled, a partial refund or alternative coverage may be provided.

9.2 In hazardous weather risking equipment damage, the photographer may miss some shots to protect gear. Alternative indoor options or schedule adjustments will be discussed beforehand. The photographer is not liable for missed photos due to weather.

9.3 If the venue becomes unavailable or restricted, it is the client's responsibility to arrange an alternative location. If no suitable alternative can be found and the event cannot be repeated, no refund will be issued for any missed coverage. Please refer to section 4.1 for further details.

9.4 Legal or regulatory changes preventing the event will lead to discussions about rescheduling. If rescheduling is impossible, a full refund will be issued, except the deposit, which will be forfeited.

9.6 If the client or their guests act with violence, threats, or harassment at the shoot location, the photographer & the team may stop coverage immediately for safety reasons. All payments, including the deposit, will be non-refundable.

10. Religious Beliefs & Accommodation

10.1 The Photographer is a practising Christian. By signing this contract, the Client acknowledges this and agrees that any requests conflicting with the Photographer's beliefs- such as explicit or inappropriate content- may be declined.

10.2 If such conflicts arise after booking, and the Photographer withdraws or limits coverage, no refunds will be given. The Client is responsible for disclosing any potentially conflicting requests before signing and paying deposits.

10.3 In case of withdrawal for belief conflicts, the Photographer may adjust photo delivery accordingly, but the Client remains responsible for paying the full outstanding balance.

11. Agreement, Client Conduct & Legal

11.1 Agreement: By signing this contract, the client confirms they have read, understood, and accepted this contract, which takes effect immediately.

11.2 Artistic Choices: Clients agree to the photographer's artistic decisions in capturing and editing images within the agreed terms.

11.3 Harassment: The photographer will not tolerate harassment from clients, their guests, vendors, or others before, during, or after the shoot. If the photographer or team feel threatened or uncomfortable, they will raise the issue with the client. If unresolved, the photographer may withdraw without refund.

11.4 Breach of Contract: If the client breaches this agreement, the photographer may terminate the contract and retain all payments, including the deposit.

11.5 Applicable Law: This agreement is governed by the laws of England and Wales.
